Rising-Stars Program (15 months - Kindergarten)

The Rising-Stars Program is our specialty program for dancers ages 15 months to Kindergarten. The program is designed to offer introductory dance classes in a fun and exciting way, while igniting the imagination and learning the discipline and art of dance.

Mommy & Me (15 months – 3 years) **Session classes may be added for our 2020-2021 season*

This is a 30-minute class designed for dancers and their caregiver to enjoy alongside each other. This class is an introduction to dance. Dancers will have fun exploring movement through creative play, rhythms and games that incorporate balance and coordination. Dancers participating in this class will NOT perform in our Spring Recital.

Class Length Per Week: 30 minutes

Monthly Cost: \$40

Shoes Needed: Girls- Pink ballet shoes (optional) or clean socks, Boys- Black ballet shoes (optional) or clean socks

Tiny Tots (15 months – 3 years)

This is a 30-minute class designed for dancers who are excited about music and movement! Dancers will begin to learn rhythms, enhance balance and coordination and explore creative movement and tumbling. Dancers will perform ONE dance in our Spring Recital and will have ONE costume.

Monthly Cost: \$40

Shoes Needed: Girls- Pink Ballet Shoes, Boys – Black Ballet Shoes

Costume & Cost: One costume, One-time fee of \$75

Pre & Kinder-Dance (3 years – 6 years)

This is a 45-minute class designed to focus on elements from Tap, Jazz, Ballet and Tumbling. Dancers will begin to understand rhythms, basic dance concepts and simple choreography. Dancers will perform TWO dances in our Spring Recital and will have ONE costume.

Class Length Per Week: 45 minutes

Monthly Cost: \$50

Shoes Needed: Girls- Pink Ballet Shoes and Tan, Strappy Tap Shoes. Boys – Black Ballet Shoes and Black-Tie Tap Shoes

Costume & Cost: One costume, One-time costume fee of \$75

Tiny Hoppers (Preschool & Kindergarten Hip Hop)

This is a 30-minute hip hop class designed for dancers looking for a fun and upbeat way to burn off energy! Dancers will learn progressions across the floor, beginner hip hop tricks and combinations. Dancers will perform ONE dance in our Spring Recital and will have ONE costume.

Class Length Per Week: 30 minutes

Monthly Cost: \$40

Shoes Needed: Clean Tennis Shoes. *Please note, for recital dancers will need to purchase the assigned tennis shoes to match their costume. More information will be sent when costumes have been picked.

Costume & Cost: One costume, One-time costume fee of \$75

Boys Hip Hop (Ages 3-6 & 7 +)

This is a 30-minute class designed for dancers looking for a fun and upbeat way to burn energy! Dancers will learn progressions across the floor, beginner hip hop tricks and combinations. Dancers will perform ONE dance in our Spring Recital and will have ONE costume.

Class Length Per Week: 30 minutes

Monthly Cost: \$40

Shoes Needed: Clean Tennis Shoes. *Please note, for recital dancers will need to purchase the assigned tennis shoes to match their costume. More information will be sent when costumes have been picked.

Costume & Cost: One costume, One-time costume fee of \$75

3rd – 5th Grade Combination Classes

These are 60-minute combination classes designed for dancers who want to learn more about the fundamentals of Tap, Jazz, Hip Hop, Ballet and Lyrical. All combination classes will perform TWO routines in our Spring Recital and will have TWO costumes.

Monthly Cost: \$40

Shoes Needed: Black, Tie Tap Shoes

Costume & Cost: One costume, One-time costume fee of \$75

6th -9th Grade Combination Classes

These are 60-minute combination classes designed for dancers who want to learn more about the fundamentals of Jazz, Hip Hop, Ballet and Lyrical. All combination classes will perform TWO routines in our Spring Recital and will have TWO costumes.

Class Combination Options: Jazz & Hip Hop, Ballet & Lyrical

Class Length Per Week: 60 minutes

Monthly Cost: \$56

Shoes Needed: **Jazz-** Tan turners

Lyrical (6th-9th Grade)

This is a 30-minute Lyrical class designed for dancers who are looking to learn more about Lyrical dance, or are wanting to become more experienced. Dancers will focus on technique, combinations and choreography and will begin to understand and develop artistry. Dancers will perform ONE routine in our Spring Recital and will have ONE costume.

Class Length Per Week: 45 minutes

Monthly Cost: \$50

Shoes Needed: Tan Turners

Costume & Cost: One costume, One-time costume fee of \$75

Registering for Classes

Creating a Family Portal: If you are new to DelMonico Dance, you will first need to create an account online to be able to register for classes. You can access the family portal from our home page on the website, www.delmonicodance.com. Once set up, you may use the family portal to view your family information, class schedule, billing statements and more. It is important you have a current email address in the portal, as the majority of information communicated is sent out by email.

Discounts, Coupons & Promotions: If you have any discounts, coupons or promotions, please make sure to make a note in the “comments section” at the bottom of the registration page.

Are You Ready for Dance Class?

Class Attire: Dancers should wear clothing that is comfortable and allows full range of motion. Examples include: leotards, dance dresses, dance or yoga pants, dance shorts, tank tops, etc. Boys may wear athletic shorts, t-shirts, etc. **No street clothes are allowed.** Dance apparel and shoes may be purchased online at [DelMonico Dance's Online Shop](#). After you purchase your apparel, shoes and accessories, it will be conveniently delivered to the studio in Lakeland!

Dance Bags: All dancers should have a bag to keep their shoes in. Please label all your child's shoes with their first and their last name. Dancers, please bring your dance bags into the dance room for easy shoe changes. For younger dancers, there will be teachers and assistants to help with shoes changes.

Class Etiquette: Please arrive to class on time. If you are running late, please have your dancer enter class in between exercises/songs to not distract other dancers. Dancers are encouraged to use the restroom before class.

Attendance and Make-up Classes: Attending class is very important for dancers. Each week we will learn new skills or new sections of the recital dance(s). If a dancer misses a class and wishes to make-up the class, please contact your dancer's instructor for make-up options. Make-ups are not required but are recommended. Dancers coming late to class should enter when music is not playing as to not distract other students

Monthly Tuition & Fees

Registration Fee: There will be an annual registration fee of \$25 due at the time of registration per dancer, along with the first month's tuition to hold your spot. For the second dancer, there will be a \$15 registration fee due. Three or more dancers will not be charged a registration fee.

Monthly Tuition:

30-minute class = \$40/per month (Dancer will have ONE costume)

45-minute class= \$50/per month (Dancer will have ONE costume)

60-minute class = \$56/per month (Dancer will have TWO costumes)

Boys Hip Hop = \$36/per month (Boys will have ONE costume.)

Family Discount: Families with multiple dancers will pay full tuition for the child taking the most hours. A 10% sibling discount will apply to the sibling taking the least number of hours. Additional siblings will get a 5% discount on tuition. September tuition and annual registration must be paid prior to the start of the class to reserve your dancer's spot.

Payment: Tuition is due on the first of every month. There is a \$25 late fee for tuition not paid by the 5th of the month. If you wish to pay with cash or check, please turn payment into the front desk before the 1st of each month.

Credit Card Processing Fee: All of our families will have an account set up in our family portal. You will be able to log on at any time to see your account history. We will automatically withdraw payments for tuition on the first of every month. If you set up your account using a checking account, you will not have a processing fee. If you prefer to use a Visa or Mastercard, your account will be charged a processing fee of \$3.00/month.

Cancelation Policy: If at any time you find the need to withdraw your dancer/s from their class/es, please contact our studio immediately with a written notice. You may send an email to info@delmonicodance.com or drop off a written note with our front desk staff. Tuition for the current month **will not** be refunded, unless the notice of withdrawal is acknowledged by our office staff before the first of the next month.

Recital Costumes

Costumes: Dancers who participate in the Spring Recital will need to purchase a costume(s) through DelMonico Dance. Dancers will be measured for costumes while in class by staff. Costumes are selected by our staff and will be age appropriate. Costumes are \$75 each. This includes the costume and tights; not shoes. Costume payments will automatically be charged to the account on file if not paid by check before the first of the month in which it is due.

***EXAMPLE:** *If your dancer is taking two classes, costume payments will be split up into two payments. Example: A Dancer taking Pre & Kinder-Dance Class and a Tiny Hoppers Class will be charged for 1st costume on January 1st and charged for the 2nd costume on February 1st.*

Class Photos & Picture Day

Class and Event Photos: We often have staff photograph dancers during class time or at special events. These photos may be posted on our website, Facebook, or in ads promoting DelMonico Dance. When registering for classes, you are agreeing that we may use any photographs taken of your dancer for these purposes. No name will ever be listed with these photographs. If you do not want your dancer's photo shared, please inform DelMonico Dance.

Picture Day: In the spring, we will have a professional photographer take individual and class pictures of all our dance classes. Students will wear their recital costumes. Please make sure you have the correct shoes and style for picture day so all dancers look uniform. Pictures will be available for purchase.

Winter Showcase & Spring Recital

Winter Showcase: We will be having our fourth annual Winter Showcase **in December 2020**. Your dancer will receive their assigned showtime in November. This will be a show where you will have the opportunity to watch your dancers shine on stage! More details will come late fall 2019.

Recital: We will have our 12th annual year-end recital in June 2021. The recital will be held at East Ridge High School in Woodbury. Dancers should arrive 45-60 minutes prior to the start of the show. Dancers will stay backstage during the recital under the supervision of a DMD staff (tiny tot and pre-school aged dancers can sit and watch the show with their parents after they dance.) More information will be communicated to you throughout the year and in the Spring.

Dress Rehearsal: All dancers in the recital are required to attend a dress rehearsal prior to our recital. This will aid in helping with any worries about being on stage and help our recital show to run smoothly. More information about the recital and the dress rehearsal will come Spring 2021.

Lobby: Parents are welcome to stay in the lobby during class. We ask that you clean up after yourself if eating or drinking. If siblings are present, no running or roughhousing allowed. Please make sure to bring a quiet activity for them to do. We ask that you do not distract your dancer during classes.
